This position reports to the Executive Director.

Primary Responsibilities

- Create and/or grow individual giving, major gifts grant funding and other fundraising initiatives.
- Significantly increase diversified and unrestricted funding.
- Help the organization define performance goals and measures for fund development; monitor results.
- Create development infrastructure needed to generate new revenue sources including fundraising software, donor information, communications, staff/volunteer training, etc.
- Establish strong internal relationships (staff, board and other volunteers), as well as with the general and donor communities.
- Identify and pursue all appropriate funding opportunities, including grants, social enterprises, and other non-traditional funding opportunities.
- Other duties as assigned to increase and support revenue.
